

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral Directors charges only) £2,547.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements:	£1,695.00
Collection and transporting the deceased person into the funeral directors care: (Normally within 15 miles of the funeral directors premises)	£ 200.00
Providing a suitable coffin:	£ 350.00
Taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium in a hearse: (At a date and time you agree with the funeral director)	£ 300.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities: (The deceased person will be kept at the funeral directors premises)	£ 1.00
Viewing of the deceased person, by appointment with the funeral director:	£ 1.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral directors charges only)	£1,645.00
Cremation (funeral directors charges plus the cremation fee)	£1,495.00

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee:	£ POE
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents:	£ POE
<i>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</i>	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee:	from £ 550.00
In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents:	£1,425.00

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional and additional products or services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Additional mileage (price per mile)	£ POE
Additional transfers of the deceased person (e.g. to their own home or place of worship)	from £ 200.00
Collection and delivery of ashes:	£ POE
Embalming:	£ POE
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant or minister of religion)	from £ 265.00
Services supplied outside of normal working hours:	£ POE
